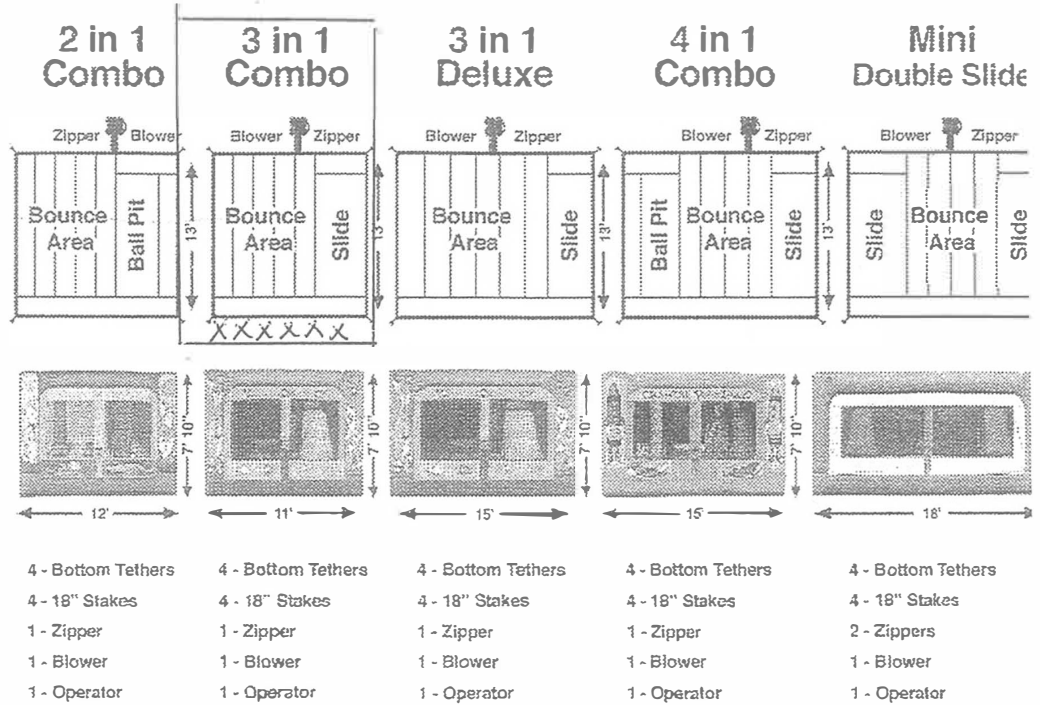

Directions

- Read "Installation and Setup Manual" completely.
- Layout ground tarp for combo.
- Position combo on tarp with a level ground area approximately 18' x 20'. Unit should have 4' clearance on all sides and 9' height clearance.
- Connect blower to air tube on unit making sure strap is firmly secure and no air is leaking.
- Blower system requires a dedicated 20 amp breaker.
- Turn blower on.
- Secure all tethers firmly to ground stakes after the unit is fully inflated.
- Bury stakes flush with ground.
- Do a safety check on the blower and extension cord.
- Do a safety check on the interior and exterior surfaces of unit looking for any moisture, debris, rips, tears or seams coming apart. (If noticed, do not use inflatable until repaired)
- Do not operate in winds over 15 m.p.h..

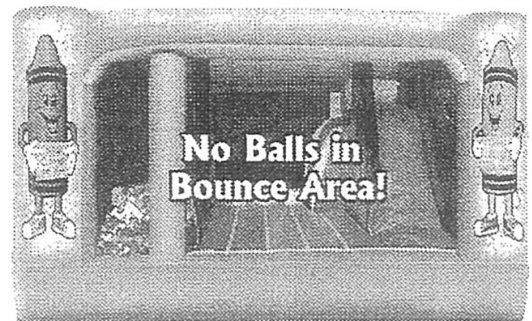

- No flips, somersaults, Diving or rough housing.

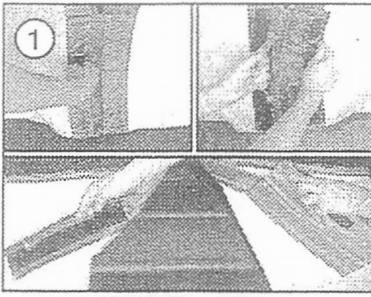

Do not overload Ball Pit area. Keep balls clean and sanitized.

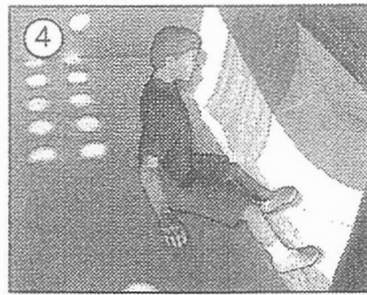

Do not allow players to throw balls at each other or serious injury may occur! Keep balls out of bouncing area or injuries may occur!

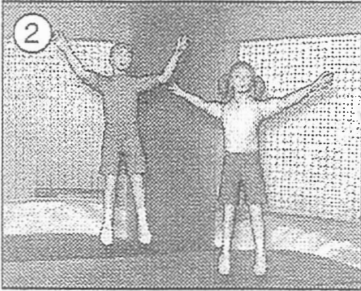
Step by step Procedures for Mini Combos



1. Pull on door handle with right hand and with left hand grab other handle and pull. Pull back both sides and enter bounce. When riders are inside, operator should lock door by connecting both sides with velcro flaps.



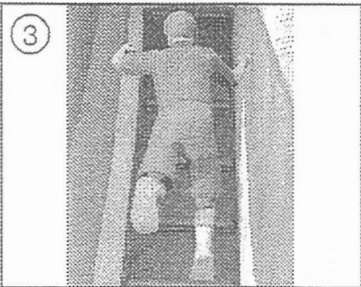
4. Sit down at the top of the slide.



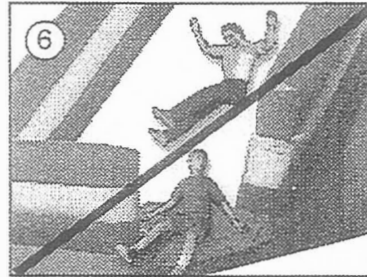
2. Start bouncing in the bouncer.



5. With arms crossed over your chest, slide down the slide feet first only.



3. Climb up the stairs by leaning forward and grabbing bars to direct you to the top of the slide.



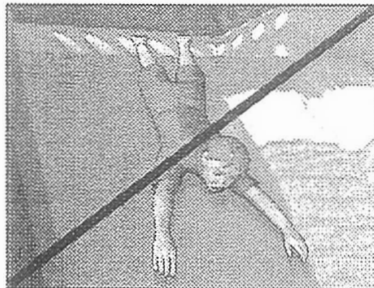
6. **KEEP LANDING AREAS CLEAR!**

- Operators should not allow participants to slide down until slide landing area is clear of riders.

AVOID INJURIES!

DO NOT enter the slide lane head first!

- Be sure to sit down at the top of the slide with your feet out in front of you, then push off going *feet first only*.



Operators must take control!

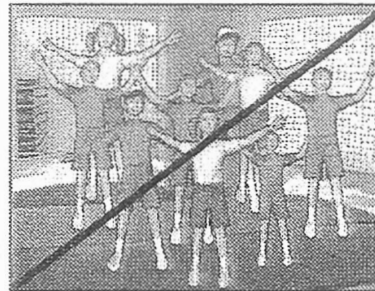
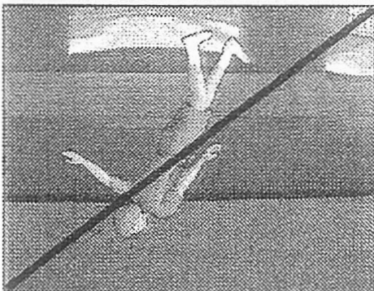
CAUTION: Do not allow more than 1 rider on slide at a time.



AVOID INJURIES!

DO NOT land head first or serious injury may occur. No flips, somersaults or rough housing!

- Be sure that you position your body upright so you do not land on your head.



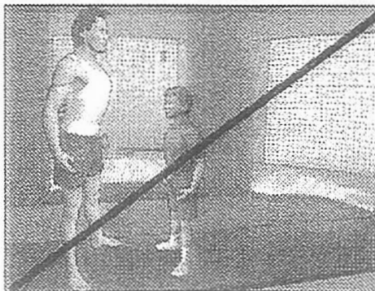
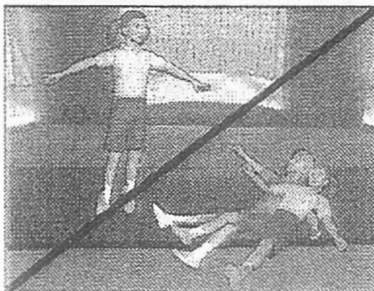
Be sure to instruct all operators of the correct procedures to have all passengers follow as they bounce in the inflatable.

WARNING!

Do not overload unit!

KEEP MATTRESS AREAS CLEAR!

- Operators should not allow participants to continue bouncing until mattress is clear of all fallen occupants.

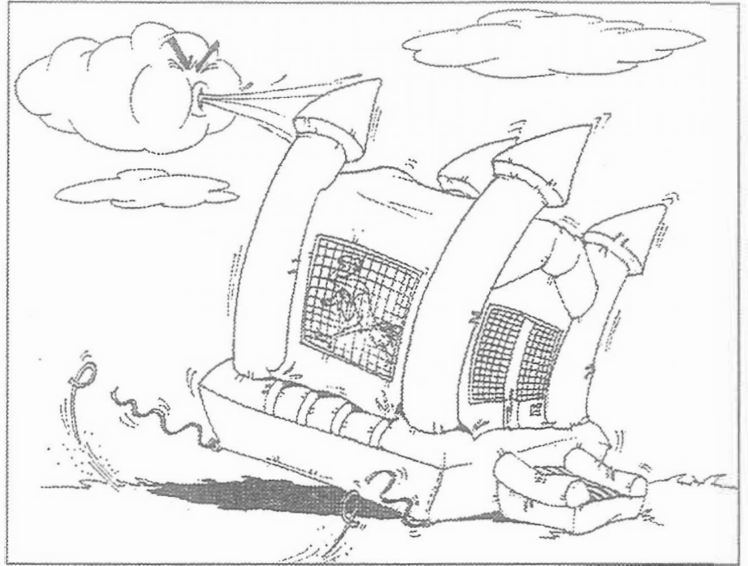

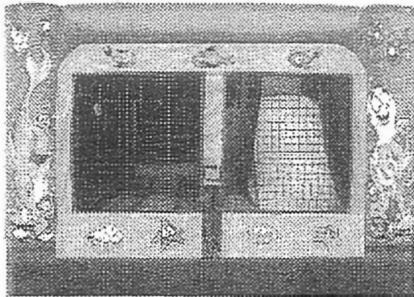


Catastrophe!

This type of catastrophe can always be avoided by proper tethering utilizing the ground stakes provided and by having Trained Operator(s) on duty and avoiding inclement weather such as high winds i.e. winds in excess of 15 m.p.h.

Procedures for evacuation!

Each blower tube has an automatic air flap that reduces the loss of air if the blower system goes off, however, all participants should be directed off the inflatable as shown by the arrow(s) below. In the event of a power outage or in an emergency take down, the participants should be directed to exit the slide and bouncer ASAP!
